



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- What grade level(s) is Education Days geared towards?
 - Education Days are geared towards those in grades 4-10. Our STEM curriculum will have lessons/worksheets geared towards these different grade levels. Our community partners have also created content for all these grade levels as well.
- What are the height requirements for the rides?
 - We have a complete list of all the rides (subject to change) and the height requirements on our website. Click [HERE](#) for the full list. Upcharge attractions: fun houses, games, bungee trampoline, and pony rides.
- What kind of food do you have available?
 - For Education Days we offer a meal voucher for \$6 which includes the option of a hot dog, bag of chips and a soda OR a slice of pizza and a soda. We also have numerous concession stands and impromptu bistros which carry a variety of food items including hamburgers, hot dogs, pizza, deli sandwiches, salads, french fries, pretzels, assorted snacks, and more. Plus, we have the Midway comprised of food trailers with carnival food such as funnel cakes, Stromboli, cotton candy other sweet treats! **No outside food or beverages are allowed in the I-X Center.**
- How long will the Education Days last?
 - Your ticket includes our special program with our sea lion trainer, Jimmy, as well as the exhibits presented by our community partners. The program will begin at 10am and will last until approximately 11am. After the conclusion of the program, you will be able to explore the community partners' stations and experience the I-X Indoor Amusement Park. You may stay all the way up until the park closes at 9pm*. However, most community partners will be ending their exhibits at 2pm.
- Does everyone need a ticket to come to Education Days, even if they are not riding any rides?
 - Yes, everyone coming to I-X Indoor Amusement Park and Education Days will need a ticket. The ticket price for Education Days is \$18 per person (\$7 off regular admission).
- Are backpacks or large bags allowed inside the park?
 - No, there are no backpacks or large bags allowed inside the park. All bags and purses are subject to search. Hand held diaper bags or bags that are part of a stroller are allowed but are subject to search. A backpack that is used as a diaper bag will not be allowed.

- Does everyone need to go through security?
 - Yes, everyone will need to pass through metal detectors upon entrance into the building.
- Is there a Dress Code?
 - Proper clothing attire must be worn at the park including: shirts, pants and shoes. No person wearing clothing with vulgar images or wording will be allowed into the park and no gang attire is allowed.
- What entrance do we enter the building?
 - You will enter the building in the West Entrance and once inside, you will go through security before entering the park.
- Where does the bus park?
 - The bus will be able to drop you off outside the West Entrance and then the bus can park in the back of the West Parking lot. Bus parking is FREE and your driver will receive a FREE ticket as well.

**After 5:00 pm, everyone under the age of 18 is required to be accompanied by a parent or parental chaperone to enter the Amusement Park. Proof of ID required.*
